

Code of Conduct for CNHC Board, Professional Committee & Profession Specific Board (PSB) Members

Introduction

- 1. The CNHC exists to protect the public by means of a voluntary register for complementary and natural healthcare practitioners
- 2. The CNHC consists of a number of component parts (Federal Regulatory Board, Committees; Profession Specific Boards).
- 3. All members commit to:
 - i) working on behalf of CNHC as a body corporate
 - ii) upholding the mission and values of the CNHC at all times
 - iii) taking decisions in the public interest without favour to any individual body corporate or other association
 - iv) acting objectively and impartially on behalf of CNHC
 - v) declaring any interests in membership of other bodies or organisations which may have an actual or potential interest in the work of CNHC
 - vi) declaring any actual or potential conflict of interest between personal activity and CNHC business, in any form
 - vii) being clear and explicit, when speaking or writing, whether CNHC or personal views are being expressed
 - viii) avoiding bias on grounds of: age; disability; gender reassignment; marriage and civil partnership; pregnancy and maternity; race; religion or belief; sex; sexual orientation
 - ix) maintaining confidentiality in relation to CNHC business
 - x) avoiding seeking personal advantage as a result of CNHC membership
 - xi) acting professionally and courteously at all times
 - xii) completing the CNHC Declaration of Interest annually and informing the Registrar immediately of any relevant changes
