

Registration with the CNHC for Nutritional Therapists

In order to be eligible to apply for registration with CNHC practitioners must have

 undertaken a programme of training that meets, as a minimum, the Nutritional Therapy National Occupational Standards and the <u>Nutritional Therapy Core</u> <u>Curriculum</u>. The minimum level of qualification is BSc (Hons), level 6 of the Framework of Higher Education Qualifications (FHEQ) in England, Northern Ireland and Wales and BSc (Hons) Level 10 of the Framework for Higher Education in Scotland (FQHEIS).

OR

 have achieved competence to the level of the Nutritional Therapy National Occupational Standards by means of relevant experience of at least three years and been assessed by their peers as having met those Standards.

Please note, courses delivered entirely by distance learning do not meet CNHC requirements.

1. Fully Accredited Courses:

The following courses meet the National Occupational Standards (NOS) and the Nutritional Therapy Core Curriculum. If you graduated from one of these courses you are eligible to apply for CNHC registration on the basis of your qualification alone.

NOTE: Any organisation that wishes a course to be added to those listed below is asked to submit an application to the <u>Nutritional Therapy Education</u> <u>Commission</u>.

2. Other courses:

The following training provider (CNM) is accredited until February 2021 and students must have started the course before 1 September 2020. In order to be considered for course accreditation beyond February 2021, CNM would be required to put forward a BSc for accreditation by the Nutritional Therapy Education Commission (NTEC):

If you started the CNM course after 1 September 2020 you may wish to approach one of the currently accredited course providers listed above and seek Accreditation of Prior Learning for what you have completed on the CNM diploma course.



3. Other training courses:

If you trained elsewhere, or at one of the above colleges outside the defined dates, then you need to present a **Full Portfolio** of evidence to register with CNHC.
