

Registration with the CNHC for Bowen Therapists

In order to be eligible to apply for registration with CNHC practitioners must have

 undertaken a programme of training that meets, as a minimum, the Bowen Therapy National Occupational Standards and the <u>Bowen Therapy Core Curriculum</u>. The minimum level of qualification required is equivalent to 3 (England and Wales); 5 (Northern Ireland); 6 (Scotland) on the <u>UK Qualification Comparison Chart</u>

OR

 have achieved competence to the level of the Bowen Therapy National Occupational Standards by means of relevant experience of at least three years and been assessed as having met those Standards.

Please note, courses delivered entirely by distance learning do not meet CNHC requirements.

The following courses meet the National Occupational Standards and the Bowen Therapy Core Curriculum. (Please note both courses are available in various locations).
