

Guidance on changing your name on the register

If you wish to change your name on the register you will need to send copies of the following information to CNHC:

Either

- a copy of your marriage certificate or civil partnership certificate

or

- a copy of your divorce certificate or civil partnership dissolution certificate, together with a copy of your birth certificate

or

- If you have changed your name for a different reason, you will need to provide one of the following documents to provide evidence of the change in name:
 - A copy of a change of name deed (known as a deed poll) confirming that your name has been changed, signed by you and someone over the age of 18 who knows you but is not related to you
 - A statutory declaration, sworn in the presence of a solicitor or magistrate, stating your intention to abandon your old name and adopt a new one.
