

Registration Policy and Payment of Fees

CNHC is the UK-wide Regulator for Complementary Therapies.

Registration with CNHC is voluntary though some

- Cancer Centres
- Hospices and
- NHS Trusts

require CNHC registration for relevant employees and volunteers.

Registration is renewable on an annual basis and each year practitioners can choose whether or not to renew their registration.

CNHC does not accept resignations from Registrants during a period of registration. This is to ensure that in the public interest no Registrant can avoid or frustrate the investigation or hearing of a complaint against them. This applies to all Registrants, irrespective of whether or not a Registrant has a complaint against them.

Payment of the initial registration fees secures entry on the CNHC Register for one year. An annual renewal fee is due for payment 12 months after the date of initial registration, and the date does not change if the registrant registers and pays for additional disciplines after the initial registration date.

Initial registration and renewal fees cannot be transferred to other disciplines.

Other than in exceptional circumstances fees are not refunded.
