

The Complementary & Natural Healthcare Council (CNHC) was set up by the government to register and regulate complementary healthcare practitioners. Our sole purpose is to protect the public.

We are the independent UK regulator and the holder of an Accredited Register approved by the Professional Standards Authority (PSA). We register practitioners across 18 complementary therapies.

Why register with CNHC?

- The government recommends the public use only an Accredited Register when choosing a practitioner who is not regulated by law.
- CNHC registration is accepted by several private health cash plan providers and insurers for reimbursement of therapy costs.
- General Medical Council (GMC) guidance allows doctors to refer patients to practitioners on an Accredited Register.
- CNHC registration demonstrates that you are committed to standing up for standards.



How do I apply to register?

CNHC works with a number of professional associations who check your training, insurance and experience to confirm if you are eligible for registration.

What is the registration fee?

The annual registration fee is £75* for your first discipline. It is then £10 for each additional discipline, up to four in total (for five or more it is free).
