CNHC's Advertising Guidance for Registrants

CNHC has detailed guidance for registrants to help them comply with the Committee of Advertising Practice (CAP) code. All those involved in advertising in any way are required to be aware of the requirements of CAP.

If you are a registrant, please read our <u>Advertising Guidance for Registrants</u> in full and use it as a resource to check the content of your website and other forms of marketing. We recommend that all CNHC registrants use the wording for their discipline that we have agreed with CAP. The discipline descriptors can be found <u>here</u>.

We have produced specific guidance about <u>advertising in relation to the Cancer Act 1939</u> which registrants should also read carefully.
