Let the Quality Mark set you apart

The Professional Standards Authority for Health and Social Care (PSA) have launched a campaign to encourage practitioners on their Accredited Registers (including the one held by CNHC) to display the Quality Mark. Making sure you comply with the law on advertising and the treatment of cancer

As a CNHC registrant, you may be practising therapies which are used by those receiving treatment for cancer. It is therefore imperative that you familiarise yourself with the provisions of the Cancer Act 1939 and take care to ensure that your advertising complies with the law.
