

All CNHC registrants must comply with the Committee of Advertising Practice (CAP) Non-Broadcast Code.

To help our registrants with compliance we have produced <u>guidance on advertising</u>. Please read it in full and use it as a resource to check the content of your website and other forms of marketing. We recommend that all CNHC registrants use the wording for their discipline that we have agreed with CAP. The discipline descriptors can be found <u>here</u>.
